This is the last Will and Testament of
me John George Curtiss of Rushcutters Bay
near Sydney in the Colony of New South Wales
formerly a Whig but now out of business After
the payment of all my just debts funeral
and testamentary expenses I give devise
and bequeath the whole of my real and
personal estate of whatsoever nature and
kind and wheresoever situate unto my dear
wife Mary Curtiss absolutely for her own
sole and separate use and benefit And I
hereby empower my Trustees hereinafter named
to sign seal and execute all conveyances and
deeds that may be necessary for the due
conveying and assuring of any land that
I may be possessed of And I hereby
revoke all former wills heretofore made by
me And I appoint my dear wife Mary
Curtiss and my friend Charles Woodward
executors executors and Trustees of this my
will In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand this eighteenth day of October
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and seventy eight
